LA PALMA DAYS BAND REVIEW AND PARADE **Saturday, November 12, 2011** **6:45 AM Guard, 7:15 AM Band – 3:00 PM**

On Saturday, November 12th, we'll have the opportunity of showcasing our talents and skills to thousands of people in the La Palma Days Band Review and Parade. 36 bands (6 middle schools) will take part in this year's event.

We'll be following the same procedures as the Placentia and Loara events. We'll perform in the band review portion and then be moved into the parade portion of the event. The entire event takes place on Walker St., beginning just south of Orangethorpe Ave. and ending, for us, in the Walker Junior High School parking lot, just south of La Palma Ave. The band review competition zone will be located On Walker Street by Bransford Drive (see attached map). Our parents and supporters should situate themselves in this area near the judges' stand for the best show.

We are scheduled to enter competition at 9:55 AM.

At the conclusion of the parade, we'll meet our buses in the Walker Junior High School parking lot. After changing and having a snack, we'll walk back up the parade route to Central Park where we'll watch the parade performances of some of the finest high school marching bands in California.

Food

We'll have our usual snacks and drinks at the bus. There will also be food vendors at Central Park. Plan on \$6.00 - \$8.00 if you wish to buy any food at the park.

Awards

The awards ceremony should begin at 2:00 PM and will be held in the park parking lot.

Rides and Attractions

There will be a carnival set up in the park offering rides and attractions. We will have some free time before awards to enjoy them. Students wishing to do so should bring extra money for this.

Not Returning on the Bus

If you have a need to leave early (all students must complete the parade before being released), you may have your parents meet us at the buses (Walker Junior High School parking lot) at 11:00 – 11:30 AM or in Central Park, 11:45 AM – 2:30 PM. You will also need to bring in a note stating that you will not be returning to Tetzlaff with us and that your parents will pick you up at the end of the parade. Your parents must sign this note. Please note that you and your parents must tell Mr. Mitts in person at the time you are leaving.

Attire

We will follow the same procedure (clothing-wise) as we did with the Placentia Parade.

Guard members: Come dressed in your uniform.

Band members: Come in your white T-shirts, shorts, black (full length) socks and black marching shoes.

Band girls: Please come to school with your hair up in a bun on top of your head (not to the back of your head).

Band boys: You hair must be off your collar. Put it up in a bun or hair net if it is long.

No jewelry of any type is to be worn while in uniform.

Please do not forget your post-parade attire of Day shirt, comfortable pants and shoes!
