LOARA BAND REVIEW

Saturday, October 29, 2011

7:20 AM Guard, 7:40 AM Band – 5:15 PM

On Saturday, October 29th, we'll be participating in the Loara Band Review in Anaheim. This is a large event with 40 bands performing. I encourage all of our families and friends to attend this prestigious and exciting event. Arrive early and get a place close to the judging stand on N. Clementine St. (just north of Pearson Park—see attached map).

The first band (Host, Loara High School) steps off at 10:55 AM. We hope our families and friends will stay for the entire event (10:59 AM – 2:09 PM) and enjoy all of the bands.

Tetzlaff is scheduled to enter competition at 11:17 AM.

After going through competition, we will walk to La Palma Park (1151 N. Anaheim Blvd, Anaheim) which is located on the corner of La Palma Ave. and Harbor Blvd. (see map) where our buses will be parked.

We'll have a snack at the buses and then walk back to the competition area to watch the last bands of the band review perform. After that, we'll walk back to La Palma Park for lunch and the awards ceremony which will be held in Glover Stadium (on the grounds of La Palma Park).

Students will want to bring ~\$10.00 for lunch.

Attire

We will follow the same procedure (clothing-wise) as we did with the Placentia Parade:

- Guard come dressed in uniform with your hair up
- Band come dressed in T-shirts, PE shorts, long black socks and black shoes.
- Band girls, put your hair up in a bun on the top of your head.
- No jewelry of any type may be worn while in uniform.
- Everyone, please remember to bring your post-parade attire:
Day shirt, comfortable pants and shoes.

Important note: **You must eat a good breakfast.** There will be approximately 6 hours between the time you arrive at Tetzlaff and the time you may eat lunch! You will be exerting a lot of energy marching, playing and performing during this time.

Not Returning on the Bus

If you have a need to leave early (all students must complete marching before being released), you may have your parents meet us at La Palma Park at our band buses between 11:40 AM and 12:30 PM. You will also need to bring in a note on or before Friday, October 28, stating that you will *not* be returning to Tetzlaff with us and that your parent or legal guardian will pick you up at the end of the competition. Your parent/legal guardian must sign this note.

Please note that you and your parent/legal guardian must tell Mr. Mitts in person at the time you are leaving.

District policy allows us to release students to their legal parent or guardian only.
